Sub: - Regarding distribution of CUG SIMs

Ref: - This office letter no 18624 dated 24th December 2012

Sir,

In partial modification to the guiding points earlier issued in the letter referred above, it is to inform you that, all CUG SIMs are now being changed to designation specific instead of the particular name of the subscriber. In this connection, you are requested to scrupulously follow the below points while providing CUG connection to a service provider of H & FW department.

- All CUGs (Except ASHA Worker) are now in the name of the post and the respective place of work as subscriber's identity. The identifications are done on the basis of the data entered at mission connect as on 5th August 2014.
- All CUG subscribers are required to hand over the CUG SIM to their successor in the case of transfer/ promotion/retirement/resignation/termination or re-positioning. In no case, the SIM is transferrable to another designation now onwards.
- If the successor is not available within 7 (Seven) days from the date of change occurred, the SIM must be handed over the BPMU/DPMU/SPMU, who will, in turn, will request for deactivation of the SIM within 3 working days after receiving the SIM. The State will deactivate the SIMs within 3 working days from the date of request for deactivation.
- No SIM should be kept idle for more than 15 working days, without being used by an authorized designated person the SIM belongs to. If such case arises, then the concerned official has to be penalized by Medical officer I/c and CDMOs as mentioned in point-4, Annexure-II of Letter No 18624 dated 24/12/2012. All such penalties imposed must be intimated to the undersigned.

- All deactivated SIMs can be re-activated after getting Activation requests of the same online.
- In case of lost or theft of CUG SIM of a subscriber, the person concern has to file an FIR in the capacity of his/her designation. BSNL will issue a new SIM with the same number after getting the FIR copy and a letter of identification from the concerned Medical Officer of Block CHC or CDMO (for district level health service providers), after depositing requisite fees for the SIM.

Any deviations to the above points would be viewed seriously.
